PREPARING FOR YOUR DEPARTURE

Arriving at the Airport. Arrive at the airport at least three hours before departure to allow adequate time to check in and go through security. dentification for International Flights. Your passport is required when checking in for your international flights. When checking in online or through the app, you must enter your passport details. At the airport, you will present your passport book to the agent at the airline counter or scan your passport book if you are checking in at a kiosk. You must also present your passport book at the security checkpoint.

Packing Tips and Dress Code

I suggest dressing in layers to accommodate fluctuating temperatures. Bring comfortable walking shoes. Many travelers opt for smart-casual attire for the Welcome and Farewell activities and group dinners. Pack your medications, valuables and electronics in your carry-on bag. Masks may still be required on some international flights. You should bring a supply of disposable surgical masks or FFP2, KN-95 or N-95 masks (cloth masks may not be acceptable) and follow the local guidelines. For your protection, make a detailed list of the contents of your suitcase.

Medication

Pack enough of your prescription medication for the duration of your trip. Security and customs personnel recommend that it should be packed in its original pharmacy containers so that the medication is prescribed for your use. You may wish to bring an extra prescription or your doctor's information, should you need to obtain more medication. You also may wish to bring an adequate supply of over-the-counter medication if you have preferred brands and particular needs.

Credit and Debit Cards

Check the back of your credit and debit cards for emergency contact phone numbers. If there is not a number that can be used internationally, obtain that number and carry it with you. Contact your bank before your departure to find out if your credit and debit cards may be used at your destination and to learn about international fees. Ask if your bank has partner banks in the countries, you will be visiting. You may be able to avoid fees by using a partner bank's ATMs. While U.S. travelers routinely use their credit cards abroad without a PIN, there may be the occasional transaction when it will be required. If you do not already have a personal identification number (PIN) for your credit card, please request one. Please memorize your personal identification numbers (PIN) for both your credit and debit cards.

Cash

The most convenient and least expensive way to get foreign currency is by withdrawing cash from an ATM with a debit card. When using ATMs, please be aware of your surroundings and guard your PIN as you would at home. Many banks have stopped offering currency exchange services because of the availability of ATMs. If you are bringing cash, you may wish to exchange your currency at the airport when you arrive. If you plan on bringing U.S. or Canadian currency, please bring notes in good condition. Dirty and torn notes may not be accepted by exchange counters. In addition, large denominations may also be refused. Coins are not accepted.

Other things to consider

-Packing tubes- help you stay organized.

-Universal power adapter- you need a power adapter almost any place in the world.

-Water bottles- help you to stay hydrated in warmer climates.

-Travel Insurance for international travel-medical is not covered when you go overseas.

-Neck Wallet- Keep your valuables close to you.

-Travel Umbrella- be prepared for all types of weather.

-TSA luggage tags- this way you will not have trouble with security

-Sun Screen- sunscreen is notoriously hard to come by and extremely expensive when it's available.

-First Aid Kit-Be prepared for minor problems.

Portugal and the Douro River Cruise



DAY 1 Depart the USA: Depart the USA on your overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal.

DAY 2 Lisbon, Portugal: Upon arrival, you'll be met by a representative of Mayflower Cruises & Tours and transferred to your hotel. The remainder of the day is at your leisure to explore Lisbon. This evening, join your Mayflower staff and fellow travelers for an included dinner. Meal: D


